

EXPORT HEIFER BUYING ORDER - Delivery March 2022

Autumn 2021 and Spring born Holstein Friesian Heifers

All heifers Must be Dehorned and healed prior to Delivery to comply with MPI regulations.

Specifications

F12+ with Friesian (e.g., 1*** bull code) and clean Friesian markings e.g., 5 white points etc.**

1. To qualify as F12+, only heifers that have sufficient ancestry showing on a suitable LIC MINDA or CRV Insight profile, with a Friesian sire, will be purchased. The heifers to be purchased are inspected and tagged with export ear tags. The heifers must not be vaccinated for IBR (Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis).

At least 6 months On Farm e.g., NAIT recorded on current grazing location, with clean health history.

2. To be eligible for testing the heifers must have resided on that NAIT location for at least 6 months and a declaration to confirm this will be completed by the vendor. The grazing location must have had no clinical cases of BVD, Johnes or Lepto in last 12 months, as confirmed by the vendor's veterinarian.

Blood Testing

3. Only heifers that pass Farm of Origin testing required to enter Pre-Export Isolation for shipment to China will be purchased. (Tests include a TB test, plus blood tests for Johnes Disease, BVD Antigen and IBR antibody). The testing will occur in timely manner. If more than 50% of the mob of cattle fail the IBR blood tests, then this contract becomes void at the discretion of the purchaser.

Delivery

4. Delivery will occur within 3 weeks of testing.

Minimum weight of the Friesian heifers will be at least 190 kg+ live weight at the time of delivery March. If lighter than (<190kg) they may, at the option of GDNZ, be rejected at induction, or purchased at full value if they make shipment weight and selection. Any heifers that are rejected at the PEI for not meeting the criteria above, will be sold on behalf of the vendor at the closest suitable sale.

Payment

5. Terms of payment are within 14 days of delivery or upon the purchaser receiving all relevant LIC transfers in MINDA, and/or completed NAIT movement whichever is the later. Full title to the property of the livestock shall not pass to the Purchaser until payment is completed.

Prices

F12+ with Friesian Sire Autumn/Spring born Up to \$1,450 (190kg at Delivery).

If lighter than (190kg) they will be purchased at base prices/ the reject price.
